## **Rules for Resolving Disputes**

- 1. Remember that Jesus said, "Blessed are the peacemakers" and not "Blessed are the argument winners."
- 2. Resolve the problem as quickly as reasonably possible.
- 3. Keep it as private as possible.
- 4. Turn down the volume.
- 5. Name calling and foul language only intensify the situation.
- 6. Identify and address the problem, not each other.
- 7. Do not exaggerate the facts.
- 8. Any dramatization is over-dramatization.
- 9. Stay on the subject. Address one problem at a time.
- 10. Do not manipulate by taking all of the blame.
- 11. Work just as hard to understand the other person as you do to make yourself understood.
- 12. Always, always be honest with yourself and the other person.
- 13. Act and respond as if God was watching you (He is).
- 14. Never argue in public or in front of the kids.
- 15. Keep a sense of humor.
